

Susan Fisher, PhD, is a Professor in the Dept. of Obstetrics, Gynecology and Reproductive Sciences, School of Medicine, University of California, San Francisco (UCSF). She is jointly appointed in the Dept. of Anatomy. Dr. Fisher is the Director of the UCSF Human Embryonic Stem Cell Program and Faculty Director of the Sandler-Moore Mass Spectrometry Core Facility. She received her Bachelor of Science degree in biology and chemistry from Hope College, Holland, Michigan, and her Ph.D. in anatomy from the University of Kentucky, Lexington, Kentucky. She completed a five-year postdoctoral fellowship in mass spectrometry at the latter institution. She joined UCSF in 1982. Awards during the last five years include: election as a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the Frontiers in Reproduction Research Pioneer Award (Marine Biological Laboratory, Burroughs Wellcome Foundation, and NIH), and the UCSF Faculty Research Award in Basic Science.
