

Professor Ashley Moffett MD, MRCP, MRCPATH, FRCOG

Is Emeritus Professor of Reproductive Immunology, University of Cambridge and Director of Research, King's College, Cambridge. She has worked on the biology of uterine Natural Killer cells for 25 years. These maternal lymphocytes recognise fetal trophoblast cells and immunogenetic studies of pregnancy disorders in her lab have shown how variations in NK receptor and HLA genes influence reproductive success. She has a background as a clinician, educated at University of Cambridge, who trained as a reproductive pathologist before leaving clinical medicine for teaching and research.
